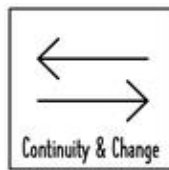


What should I already know?

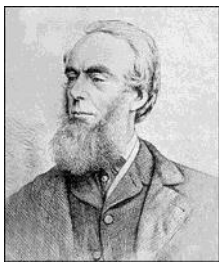
- That some events, people and places are significant in history.

National Trust

James Bateman moved to Biddulph Grange in 1842. He lived there for 27 years and collected plants from around the world for his garden.

In 1872, Robert Heath bought Biddulph Grange and lived there for nearly 50 years.

In 1896 a fire destroyed much of the house.

In 1924 Biddulph Grange became a hospital.

In 1991 the hospital closed and the National Trust bought Biddulph Grange.
