

Orbit	The path of an object around a star, planet, or moon.
NASA	National Aeronautics and Space Administration. The United States government agency responsible for the space program.
Rivalry	A competition for the same thing.
The Apollo Program	A series of space flights led by the United States with the aim of putting a man on the moon.
The Soviet Union (USSR)	A country which existed from 1922 to 1991 and was the largest and one of the most powerful countries in the world. Its largest state was the Russian republic, which is now Russia.
