



## <u>VOCABULARY</u>

| solo    | a piece or a section of a piece played or sung by a<br>single performer, who may be performing<br>completely alone or supported by an<br>accompanying instrument such as a piano. |

| compose | to make/write your own music.   |
| melody  | a series of notes creating a distinctive and<br>memorable sequence (often referred to as 'the<br>tune').  |
| violin  | A four stringed wooden instrument that is a<br>member of the string family. Played with a bow.<br>The leader of an orchestra plays the violin.                                    |

## COMPOSER: RALPH VAUGHAN WILLIAMS

BORN: 12 Oct 1872 DIED: 26 August 1958 NATIONALITY: British



He was an English 20th Century composer who wrote symphonies, chamber music, opera, choral pieces, and film scores. He's been described as 'the most important English composer of his generation'.

Vaughan Williams' The Lark Ascending was based on a poem of the same name by English poet George Meredith. The composer wrote his work while in service with the British army in World War One. Some say that the skylark could be seen soaring above the trenches.
