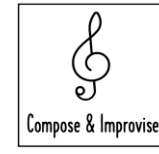
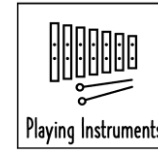




Weaving Concepts

VOCABULARY

Other songs we will listen to, with a similar theme are:

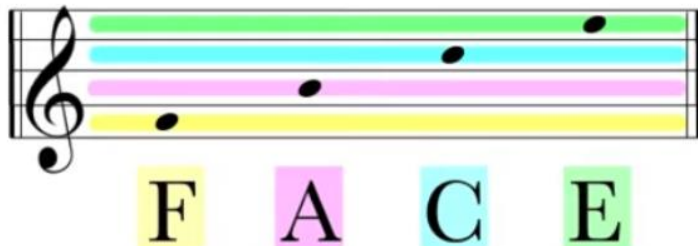
- Count On Me by Bruno Mars
