**Garnet:** In maths Garnet class have been learning about fractions. They focused a lot on halves. They looked at what shapes look like when they are halved as well as quantities.

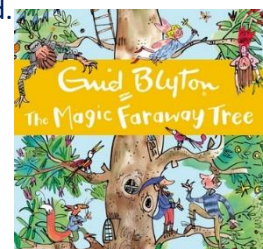
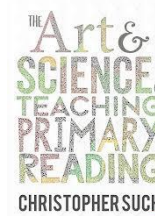
