Garnet: In Art, the children have used different grades of pencils to create texture and tone. The created some lovely pieces of artwork.

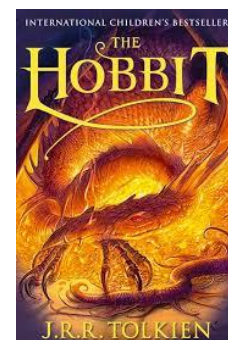
