What should I already know?

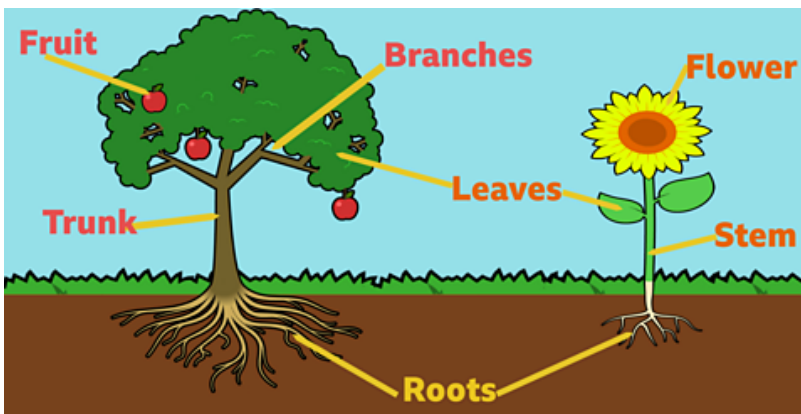
- That there are different types of plants.

Vocabulary

Wild Plant	A plant that grows from a seed wherever it falls and without human help.
Garden Plant	A plant that people plant and choose to let grow in their garden.
Weed	A wild plant that grows in places where people don't want them.
Deciduous	A tree that loses its leaves/spines during autumn and winter.
Evergreen	A tree that keeps its green leaves/spines all year.
