

Vocabulary	
Pottery	Pots, dishes and other items made from 'fired' clay.
Kiln	A furnace or oven for baking, or drying, especially one for firing pottery.
Bottle Kiln	A bottle kiln, or bottle oven, is a type of kiln. The word 'bottle' refers to the shape of the structure.
Manufacture	To make something on a large scale using machinery.
Industrial Revolution	A time of major change, when many factories were built and products were made using
Potter	A person who makes pots.
Wealthy	Having a lot of money.
