I can shape and model from observation and imagination.


Y2: I can carve, pinch and roll coils and slabs using a modelling media.

Key Vocabulary	
Form	Three-dimensional and enclosed space.
Coiling	Roll the clay until it forms a long roll. By placing one coil on top of another, different shapes are formed.
Slip	The suspension of clay particles in water.
