WHAT SHOULD I ALREADY KNOW?

What will I learn?

Theme: ABBA's music.

Facts/info: ABBA was a Swedish pop group formed in 1972.

You will listen to some other ABBA songs/pieces:

- Super Trouper
- Thank You For The Music

You will learn the song Mamma Mia, sing in **unison** and identify the song

structure: Intro, verse, bridge, chorus, introduction, verse, bridge, chorus.

You will improvise using up to 3 notes – G, A + B.

Finally, you will perform the song, including an improvisation.

VOCABULARY

structure	every piece of music has a structure e.g. an introduction, verse and chorus ending.
texture	layers of sound. Layers of sound working together make music very interesting to listen to.
unison	everyone plays or sings the same music at the same time.

Words you will hear and need to know:: Keyboard, electric guitar, bass, drums. improvise, compose, melody, pulse, rhythm, pitch, tempo, dynamics, compose, improvise, hook, riff, melody, solo, pentatonic scale
